- (1) Rie is a high school student. When she was walking with her dog one Sunday afternoon, she saw her neighbor, Mr. Takada. He was a friendly man, so she liked him very much. He worked in the city hall, and told her about the campaign to collect litter on the roads. He asked, "Can you take part in it next Saturday?" She said, "I'd love to, but I can't." She was going to have a tennis match on Saturday though the campaign sounded interesting to her. Mr. Takada said, "There are some other campaigns to clean our city. Please take part in them when you aren't busy." A few weeks later, she took part in the campaign to clean the river. Rie was surprised because many people came to the river for the campaign. She felt good after she cleaned it with people in her city. The experience of taking part in the campaign gave her a chance to think about the environment.

- (2) Kota is a junior high school student. He often uses his computer to send emails to his friends. One day in September, when he came back home from school, his mother was writing a letter. He said to her, "Why don't you send an email? It's easier. I'll teach you if you don't know." She said, "Thank you, Kota, but I want to send a handwritten message to my friend." Two weeks later, his parents had a birthday party for him. He wanted to invite his grandmother to his party, but he couldn't. He heard from his parents that his grandmother didn't feel well. She lived far away from his house. So it would be difficult for her to travel. Kota got a birthday card from his grandmother on his birthday though she couldn't come to his house. He felt very happy when he read the wonderful message written by her. When he looked at her handwriting, he remembered his grandmother's face.

- (3) Ami is fifteen. One Sunday, she saw a foreign woman in front of the station. The woman came to her and asked her a question. Ami felt nervous because she had no experience of talking with foreign people in English out of the classroom. The woman wanted to know the way to a toy store to buy a present for her little brother. Ami said to her, "I'm going to see a movie with my cousin soon. When she comes here, we will take you to a nice toy store near the movie theater. When I was small, my father sometimes took me there." She said with a smile, "Thank you very much for your kindness." Five minutes later, her cousin, Takako, arrived at the station. Both Ami and Takako tried to talk with her in English while they were walking to the toy store. It was interesting for them to interact with the foreign woman. After this event, they started to study harder to improve their English.
