For High School and Technical College Students School Year 2024 Mie Prefectural High School Education Loans

Overview

The Mie Prefectural Government offers interest-free educational loans to support students who wish to attend high schools but cannot due to financial difficulties. The loan must be repaid after graduating so that the students in the next generation can take the educational loans too.

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Your parent and/or a guardian reside in Mie Prefecture (for adult applicants, they must reside in Mie)
- 2. You currently attend high school
- 3. The total income of your family does not exceed the set limit (*Note)
- 4. You have the desire to study and complete all required school work
- 5. You have a co-signer for loan repayment other than your parents

(*Note) The table below shows a general idea of the "set limit".

Prefectural Board of Education

O When to Apply: Applications are accepted from late May through early June. The exact deadline is decided by each high

school. For more information, please contact your school (or the Educational Finance Division, Mie

Prefectural Board of Education Office if you go to school outside Mie Prefecture),

O Required Documents: Application Form, Residence Certificates of everyone in the household (*Note1) and the fiscal year 2024

certificate of income and taxation (that shows the income earned in 2023) of everyone in the household

excluding grandparents and siblings (*Note2)

(*Note1) Residence Certificate (one without "My Number" data).

(*Note2) Documents are available from June at your local government office, please contact them for details.

Additional Information

- 1. The loans must be <u>repaid within 12 years after graduating (within 15 or 18 years if the total loan amount exceeds a certain amount)</u>. If you go on to further education at college or university, you may apply for an extension. Any loans not repaid by the due date may accrue interest. Legal actions may be taken for the payment collection for accumulated delinquency.
- A co-signer other than your parents is required when you apply for the loan (who, in principle, resides in Mie prefecture, is 65 or under on the first
 day of the loan payment month and has the ability to repay the loan for you). You shall be required to present the co-signer's certificate of seal
 registration when you are accepted for the loan and when the repayment is processed.
- In case of extenuating circumstances in family finances such as unemployment or natural disasters, you can apply for the loan after the application deadline.
