Mie Prefectural High Schools are introducing digital lessons!

"1 device for 1 student"

Students are required to purchase one designated electronic device (laptop computer) when they enroll in a prefectural school.

- Q 1 Will all high schools purchase the same type of device?
- A 1 No, different high schools may require different devices. The price of purchasing a learning device includes the device itself, device management software, a three year warranty, and initial settings. Details about required devices for students who will enroll in 2026 will be posted on the Mie Prefectural Board of Education website in November 2025. (Scan the QR code on the right to access the website.)

 For your reference: For the 2024-2025 school year, 51 out of 57 high schools required parents to purchase a Chromebook for 48,565 yen each, while the other 4 schools required the purchase of an iPad, and one school required the purchase of a Windows Laptop. - Q 2 Should students purchase a device in advance?

- A 2 No, students do not have to purchase a device before admission into their school. Students will be contacted by their school about how to purchase their device following the announcement of high school entrance results in March 2025. In addition, if certain conditions are met, you may use a device that you already own. For details, please contact the school after you have decided on a school of higher education.

 For your reference: The students who entered this year (April 2025) purchased a Chromebook through the EC site for Mie Prefectural High Schools (a website for electronic commercial transactions). The schools that require an iPad will go through a different purchasing method.
- Q 3 What should students do if they require financial assistance to purchase a device?
- A 3 Schools will be lending out devices provided by the Mie Prefectural Board of Education to students in need. For further information, direct your inquiries to the school.
- Q 4 Are students allowed to use their device freely at home?
- A 4 Yes, they are allowed to use their device freely. However, students will be required to install software to restrict access to inappropriate sites and downloads. Students are responsible for charging their device at home. Each family is responsible for the cost associated with charging the device. **
- Q 5 What is the procedure for students of special needs schools?
- A 5 At special needs schools, the cost of the device will be supplemented by the Special Support Education Scholarship Incentive. Please confirm the details, including how to purchase the device, with the school.

*For households receiving scholarship benefits for high school students, the scholarship will be awarded in the form of a monthly stipend that can be used to cover school fees, including an amount allotted towards the cost of charging the device.
